

**RIVERFRONT COMMITTEE-MONDAY, MAY 6, 2024-4:30 PM
AT THE BUFFALO CITY MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

The Buffalo City Riverfront Committee was called to order by chairman Ben Holien. Present: Larry Johansen, Citizen Nick Kuhn and Clerk Jenny Ehlenfeldt.

Committee reviewed the lifejacket kiosk plan proposed by Eagle Scout Rylan Patzner. Plan and location chosen look good to the committee. Will give Patzner the go ahead to install in the next few weeks.

Discussed changes to the Riverfront Management Plan with the Corps of Engineers. Committee term limits were discussed. Will propose changing term limits for alderperson and citizen to 4 years. Discussion on changes to dock specifications. Would like to set guidelines for setbacks from dock to permit lines in the water. Committee will propose changing guidelines to state 20' sections must leave 5' or more on each side of dock and 40'+ sections must leave 8' or more more on each side of dock. Discussed the committee having the final say on permits. Variances from the dock guidelines due to water and navigation can be made at the committee's discretion per the plan. Changes in how permits are approved will also be proposed. Committee will not allow any work to start until space is marked on River Road, and clerk must be notified when work is completed so it can be verified that it meets permit specifications.

Reviewed several structure permits that the clerk has received in the past several months. Five permits were approved. Two will need further review with applicants.

Set riverfront inspection date for Monday, May 20th.

Motion Johansen, second Kuhn to adjourn the meeting. All yes, motion carried.
